Happy Birthday Jesus!

Dear Chosen One: This is the season of joy and giving. While no one knows the exact day or month of Jesus' birth, Christians around the world set aside **December 25th** to celebrate His birth.

The date itself is not what matters most. What is important is that we acknowledge, proclaim, and celebrate the fact that our Lord and Savior was born. The Bible tells us He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. In Luke 1:26–28 we read:

“In the sixth month, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin’s name was Mary. The angel went to her and said, ‘Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you.’”

Some argue that because Jesus was not born on December 25th, there is no reason to celebrate. But I rejoice that He was born—because I was a sinner in need of a Savior. Scripture reminds us that we were all born in sin and shaped in iniquity. Every person needs Jesus, though many still live in denial.

Unlike any other religious leader—Mohammad, Buddha, Krishna, or Confucius—Jesus alone was conceived by the Holy Spirit, died for our sins, and rose again on the third day. He is God manifested in human flesh.

When Philip asked to see the Father, Jesus replied: *“Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father... Don’t you believe that I am in the*

Father, and that the Father is in me?” (John 14:9–10a)

The Apostle John also declared:

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.” YES. Jesus, the Word, was with God in the beginning. “Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made. In Him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not overcome it. (John 1:1–5)

Jesus is eternal. He is the Alpha and the Omega (Revelation 1:8). He came to earth at an appointed time to fulfill His mission: healing the sick, feeding the hungry, raising the dead, preaching the Good News, and showing God’s love in action.

Though crucified, He rose victoriously and ascended to the right hand of the Father, where He intercedes for us (Romans 8:34). The Bible says the same Jesus who was resurrected and who ascended into heaven will come back with the shout of a trumpet and the dead in Christ will rise and meet Him in the air.

As Christians, we don’t just celebrate Jesus’ birth—we also celebrate His victory over sin and death. Because He lives, we have hope, freedom, and purpose. It doesn’t matter the exact date—what matters is that our Redeemer lives!

Take time this season to reflect on God’s goodness. He sent His only Son to die for you

(John 3:16). Jesus gave His life to redeem, restore, and liberate you, and He has given the Holy Spirit to dwell in those who believe. That is reason enough to celebrate His birth.
