EVERY KNEE WILL BOW AND CONFESS JESUS!

Dear Chosen One,

The Bible says God exalted Jesus to the highest place in heaven. Jesus sits on His throne at the right hand of God, yet many people believe that when they bow down and honor Him, they are doing both God and Jesus a favor.

Today, in our society, respect and honor no longer seem to exist. Many people—especially this young generation—do not show respect to anyone. Sadly, this same attitude has crept into many churches. Some people go to church with the mindset that they are doing God a favor just by showing up. So when the pastor or minister asks them to stand in reverence to the Word of God, many remain seated.

Many Christians have become so worldly that they no longer reverence the Word of God. When a person doesn't honor God for who He is or recognize Jesus for what He has done, they are demonstrating a form of rebellion. The Bible says, **“that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father”** (Philippians 2:10–11).

What is even more disturbing to me is that these same people who do not want to bow in reverence to divinity will get on their knees for humanity. They will perform all kinds of tasks with their knees to the ground for bosses, friends, lovers, and many other people. The lust of the world will make some people bow for money, recognition, popularity, self-gratification—and oh yes, let us not forget sin. Some people will get on their knees and plead for mercy

from others, but they will not get on their knees and pray to God.

If you think I am out of touch with reality, then let me ask you: When was the last time you knelt down to pray? When was the last time you kneeled at an altar in church or during a public service to worship and reverence God? When was the last time you were so caught up in worship that you did not care what others said or thought about you? This behavior is not old-fashioned—many Christians have simply stopped doing it. Some believe this kind of devotion will mess up their worldly image and reputation.

Jesus says, “If anyone would come after Me, he [or she] must deny himself [or herself] and take up his [or her] cross daily and follow Me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for Me will save it. What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, and yet lose or forfeit their soul? If anyone is ashamed of Me and My words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when He comes in His glory and in the glory of the Father and of the holy angels” (Luke 9:23–26). Today, many people want to follow Christ and profess Christianity, but they do not want to obey biblical principles.

Many claim they can serve God without reverencing His Son—JESUS—or accepting the Holy Spirit. This concept is unscriptural. God reveals Himself through His Son and through the Holy Spirit. The Holy Trinity cannot be separated to appease people. Therefore, a person cannot truly honor God without acknowledging Jesus and reverencing the Holy Spirit.

CONFESS JESUS IS LORD BEFORE IT'S TOO LATE!

If you are professing Christianity and you are the only one who knows about your faith, the truth is not in you. If your children, loved ones, friends, and co-workers have never seen you praying on your knees or heard you confess Jesus Christ as your Savior, you need to examine your motives. How do you expect to win others to Christ if you are not rooted and grounded in your faith and living by biblical principles? How can someone follow you if you don't know where you are going?

We, the Body of Christ, are called to be imitators of Jesus Christ. The Apostle Paul told his followers in 1 Corinthians 11:1 **“You are to imitate me, just as I imitate Christ.”** Jesus told Philip, **“If you have seen Me, you have seen the Father”** (Ephesians 5:1). Yes, we were created in the image of God, but in order to imitate Christ, we must spend time in His presence and read our Bible—the Word of God.

Jesus spent time on His knees praying and honoring His Father, so why are you not doing the same?

There are many people professing Christianity simply because they attend Sunday services. They slip into church and give God their two or three hours of lip service, and after church is over, they go back to living according to the world's standards. These individuals profess Christianity with their mouths, but their hearts are far from God. They are “churchgoers” who do not have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

On the other hand, there are also some pastors who claim they are preaching the Gospel but leave out Jesus' Name. They have omitted His Name from their sermons for fear of offending others in the congregation. Instead of saving souls, they are “saving face.” The Bible tells us not to be conformed to this world, but to be transformed by renewing our minds through the Word of God and by imitating Jesus.

The evidence of Christianity is LOVE. But you must be true to yourself in order to share what is in your heart. You were bought with a price—Jesus' life. You can become a light in the darkness by

demonstrating God's love and telling others about the free gift of salvation.

You can share the gift of salvation with others by first leading them to repent of their sins and then guiding them to confess the prayer found in Romans 10:9-10. **“That if you confess the with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”**

Don't be ashamed to let others see you on your knees praying or hear you confess the Name of Jesus. Be bold. Read your Bible anytime and anywhere and imitate Christ through your behavior. It is time for Christians to reveal their true identity and stop hiding. While some Christians are hiding their faith, unbelievers are not ashamed to display their acts of lawlessness to the world.

Prostitutes are not ashamed to advertise their immoral profession. Homosexuals are not ashamed to fight for equality and what they call “gay rights.” Radical Muslims are not afraid to kill innocent people to become martyrs for their gods. Many ungodly people openly confess and promote their ideologies. So, tell me, why are the Spirit-filled, blood-washed saints sitting down instead of taking a stand for Jesus?

Yes! Every knee—angels, humans, demons, sickness, poverty, death, and every other force—will bow down and reverence Jesus Christ. Take this message to heart and reexamine your spiritual life and your relationship with Him. If you are unsure, recommit your life to Jesus and reverence Him.

May God's grace overflow in your life as well. May His wisdom guide every decision you make, His light shine brightly in your path, and His peace guard your heart and mind each day.

May you walk confidently knowing you are covered in favor, surrounded by love, and strengthened for every season.
